The content will showcase recovery-focused, trauma-informed, consumer-centred, and strengths-based models of care.

With a new WA mental health and Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) strategy expected in 2024, the upcoming "Solutions in Motion" conference will be a catalyst for positive change. This year's theme will give practical expression to what we want the future mental health in WA to look like as we work towards recovery-oriented and community-focused system. "Solutions in Motion" will highlight what's working well in our system that should be built upon as well as share new insights and ideas.
