## CAbout the CAwards

The Western Australian Mental Health Awards 2023 will be held in November in Perth. Hosted by the Western Australian Association for Mental Health (WAAMH) with the support from the WA Mental Health Commission and Lotterywest, the WA Mental Health Awards will celebrate individuals, corporates, organisations and groups that have made an outstanding contribution to mental health in Western Australia throughout the 2022 calendar year.

Anyone can nominate an individual, organisation or group and self-nominations are welcomed. However, should a business wish to sponsor a category, they are then not permitted to enter that particular category. Winners will be announced at an official ceremony, followed by a celebration and networking function, with guests, award nominees and winners, sponsors and VIPs.

#### The Awards aim to:

- \* Recognise and reward the achievements of those who demonstrate excellence, innovation and initiative in supporting carers and consumers of mental health or their local community (including workplaces).
- Showcases the achievements of the mental health sector in WA.
- Present an opportunity for organisations to show their support of mental health within the local community through sponsorship.
- Inspire others to strive for excellence.
- Promote positive messaging around mental health, breaking down stigma and starting conversations for healing and recovery.

This prospectus contains information about becoming the sole naming rights sponsor of an award category and other partnership opportunities available.

### Invitation to Partner

You are invited to play a high profile role in the WA Mental Health Awards by becoming a naming rights sponsor of one of the nine award categories. This is a limited and fantastic opportunity to showcase your business and align your brand with a community-minded, prestigious event committed to building a more mentally health, connected State.

Organisations can select a WA Mental Health Award category to sponsor for the cost of \$4,000 excl. GST. There will be only one naming rights sponsor per category.

### Categories



#### MINISTER'S AWARD

This award is to celebrate an 'all star' and their overall outstanding contribution to mental health in WA. The Minister's Award recognises someone who has displayed best practice at every level, a true dedication to service in the mental health sector in the 2022 calendar year and has proven to hold an all-round skills set to benefit the outcomes for people living with mental health challenges in our community, including their families and carers.

Who can nominate:

Nominations for this award are open to any employee, leader, volunteer, advocate, person with lived experience, or maybe all of the above!

Please note: Sponsorship is not available for this category.



#### MENTAL HEALTH EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER **EXCELLENCE AWARD**

An outstanding contribution to mental health in WA by an individual employed or volunteering within WA's mental health sector.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to any individual who is paid employee or volunteer (unpaid) within the mental health sector of WA.



#### DIVERSITY AWARD

An individual, organisation or group that embraces diversity and promotes inclusion, with an initiative that benefits a particular population group - including, but not limited to youth, culturally and linguistically diverse, seniors, Aboriginal people, or LGBTQIA+.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to any individual, origination or group



#### LIVED EXPERIENCE IMPACT & INSPIRATION AWARD

This award recognises the outstanding contribution to mental health in WA that an individual who identifies as having a lived experience (consumer, carer or family member) has made.

Who can nominate:

Nominations are open to any individual who identifies as having personal experience of a mental health challenge, or is a family member, carer or support person to someone who does.



#### PROMOTION OR PREVENTION AWARD

An outstanding contribution to prevention and/or promotion in mental health.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to any organisation group or project.



#### MENTALLY HEATHY EDUCATION AWARD

This award recognises education institutions or individual educators that encourage positive mental health for students, staff and/or volunteers in WA.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to education institutions within WA and educators working in the state at an education institution.



#### MENTALLY HEALTHY WORKPLACE AWARD

A WA workplace that encourages excellent mental health for its staff and volunteers through initiatives, programs, procedures, policies and/or organisational culture.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to any organisation operating within WA.



#### INNOVATION FOR CHANGE AWARD

Outstanding innovation in driving change for better mental health in WA, through a specific initiative by an individual(s), organisation, group or project.

Who can nominate:

This award is open to any organisation, group or project for a specific initiative.



#### MENTAL HEALTH NEWS MEDIA AWARD

This award recognises excellence in journalism and reporting on mental health in WA.

Who can nominate:

Nominations for this award are open to a media professional (including freelancers) whose work was effective contributing to a wider understanding of mental health and explored issues of importance; while also exhibiting best practice journalism and use recovery-oriented language when reporting on sensitive topics around mental health.

Nominations can be based on a single piece of work or multiple related pieces forming a series, and is open to all mediums, including print, audio or video broadcast (including podcasts, documentaries etc.) and digital/online media. The nominated work must be written/produced by a WA-based media professional or WA media organisation, which was published/broadcast within the state or to a WA readership/audience.






