The Western Australian Mental Health Awards 2024 will be held in November in Perth. Hosted by the Western Australian Association for Mental Health (WAAMH) with the support from the WA Mental Health Commission and Lotterywest, the WA Mental Health Awards will celebrate individuals, corporates, organisations and groups that have made an outstanding contribution to mental health in Western Australia throughout the 2023 calendar year.

Anyone can nominate an individual, organisation or group. However, should a business wish to sponsor a category, they are then not permitted to enter that particular category. Winners will be announced at an official ceremony, followed by a celebration and networking function, with guests, award nominees and winners, sponsors and VIPs.

The Awards aim to:

- * Recognise and reward the achievements of those who demonstrate excellence, innovation and initiative in supporting carers and consumers of mental health or their local community (including workplaces).
- Showcases the achievements of the mental health sector in WA.
- Present an opportunity for organisations to show their support of mental health within the local community through sponsorship.
- → Inspire others to strive for excellence.
- Promote positive messaging around mental health, breaking down stigma and starting conversations for healing and recovery.

This prospectus contains information about becoming the sole naming rights sponsor of an award category.

Invitation to Partner

MINISTER'S AWARD

This award is to celebrate an overall outstanding contribution to mental health in WA.

The Minister's Award recognises a person who has displayed best practice in the mental health sector in the 2023 calendar year. The nominee has had a positive impact working with people living with mental health challenges in our community, including their families and carers. Nominations for this award are open to any employee, leader, volunteer, advocate or person with lived experience.

Please note: Sponsorship is not available for this category.



MENTAL HEALTH EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER **EXCELLENCE AWARD**

An outstanding contribution to mental health in WA by an individual employed or volunteering within WA's mental health sector.



DIVERSITY & INCLUSION AWARD

This award is for an individual, organisation or group that embraces diversity and promotes inclusion, with an initiative that benefits a particular population group - including, but not limited to - culturally and linguistically diverse, age, ability, Aboriginal people and LGBTQIA+.



LIVED EXPERIENCE IMPACT & INSPIRATION AWARD

This award celebrates the outstanding contribution to mental health in WA that an individual who identifies as having a lived experience (consumer, carer or family member) has made to the community.

Judges are looking an individual has demonstrated how they have improved the lives and wellbeing of others in the community and/or raised awareness of mental health challenges in WA.



PROMOTION OR PREVENTION AWARD

This award celebrates an outstanding contribution to prevention and/or promotion in mental health in WA for people with moderate, severe and persistent mental health challenges.

Nominations will have helped promote positive mental health or prevent/reduce the impact of mental health issues. They will have demonstrated strong engagement with mental health consumers or the sector and/or the wider WA community.

Nominations are open to any individual, organisation, group or project.



MENTAL HEATH EDUCATION AWARD

This award recognises an education institution that encourages positive mental health for students, staff and/or volunteers in the education system. Nominations are open to education institutions within WA. Applicable education institutions can include early childhood learning centres, kindergarten, primary and high schools, universities, TAFE and registered training organisations (RTOs).



MENTALLY HEALTHY WORKPLACE AWARD

This award recognises a WA workplace that encourages excellent mental health for its staff and volunteers through initiatives, programs, and/or organisational culture.

Judges are looking for employers/businesses who demonstrate excellence in mental health promotion within the workplace.



INNOVATION IN SERVICE DELIVERY AWARD

This award recognises a person, team or organisation

operating in the Mental Health Sector who has developed new or innovative approach to service delivery improving the lives of people with lived experience of mental health challenges. The new approach has been trialled, tested and found to be a solution which has improved the outcomes mental health challenges. The innovation may be in

from the perspective of people with lived experience of relation to an approach or process which may have been prompted by feedback from people with a mental health challenge, families or carers or be a result of codesign with people with a mental health challenge.



MENTAL HEALTH NEWS MEDIA AWARD

This award recognises excellence in journalism, reporting and media relating to mental health in WA. Nominations open to all mediums, including print, audio or video broadcast (including podcasts, documentaries etc.) and digital/online media.






