With thanks to the support of the Mental Health Commission. WA Association for Mental Health (WAAMH) is delighted to announce that the WA Mental Health Conference 2017 will also see the launch of the brand new WA Mental Health Awards.

Since the discontinuation of the Mental Health Commission's Good Outcomes Awards after 2015, the mental health sector has had no formal awards of this nature.

The new WA Mental Health Awards will fill the gap, recognising innovation and excellence in mental health practice and culminating in the Awards Ceremony and our Gala Cocktail Dinner, on Thursday evening 13 July at the Conference venue.

The new awards will be owned and driven by the mental health community, with guidance from our reference group of 17 stakeholders including people with lived experience and government, service provider, education and business representatives.

By integrating the Awards into the conference event, presented in the iconic Perth Concert Hall, we are anticipating a very high profile, and well attended gala event which will inspire excellence and lift the visibility of mental health issues.

The initial Conference Sponsorship Prospectus has already been distributed and we sincerely thank the 36 sponsors and contributors who have already shown their support.

This updated package includes the **newly released Awards** packages, along with the remaining conference sponsorship opportunities and our other just revealed event - Frame of Mind: An evening of stories and laughter with Good News Week's Mikey Robins, supporting mental health awareness and suicide prevention in WA.

Target audience
