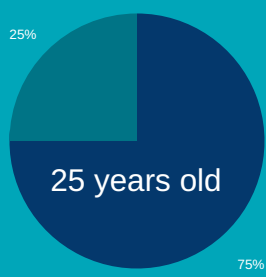

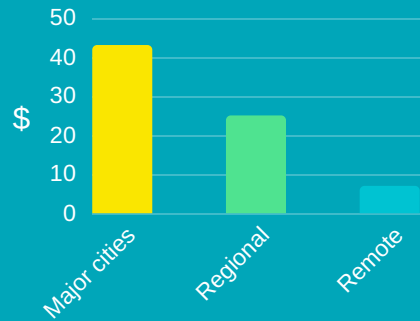
75% of mental health issues emerge by the age of 25

Cost to the Australian economy of mental health issues

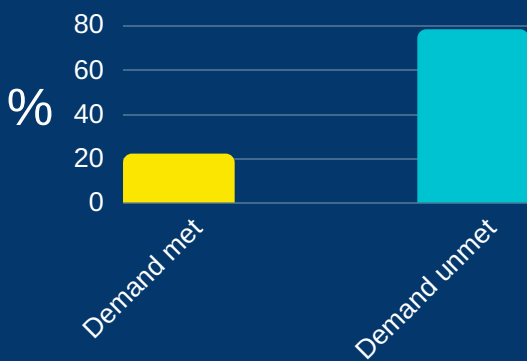


Suicide is the leading cause of death for 5-17 and 15-44 age groups

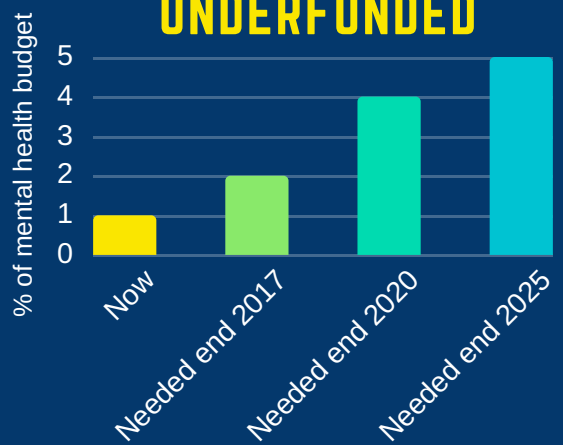


Medicare funding per person on mental health services

WITHOUT EFFECTIVE SUPPORTS

- ✗ Increased mental health problems
- ✗ Increased homelessness
- ✗ Increased demand for acute services
- ✗ Increased suicide
- ✗ Increased costs



WITH EFFECTIVE SUPPORTS

- ✓ Decreased social and economic costs
- ✓ Decreased demand for acute services
- ✓ Better mental health
- ✓ Better outcomes
- ✓ Better value



PREVENTION, EARLY INTERVENTION & COMMUNITY SUPPORT SAVES MONEY

- ✓ Save **\$84K** per person per year with supported housing
- ✓ Increase employment from **23% to 61%** with support
- ✓ Save **\$45K - \$674K** per person over 9 years with early treatment
- ✓ Save **\$1.4 - \$2.4** for every \$1 spent to prevent imprisonment
