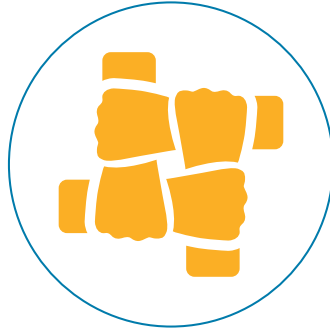
About WAAMH & Our Mission
