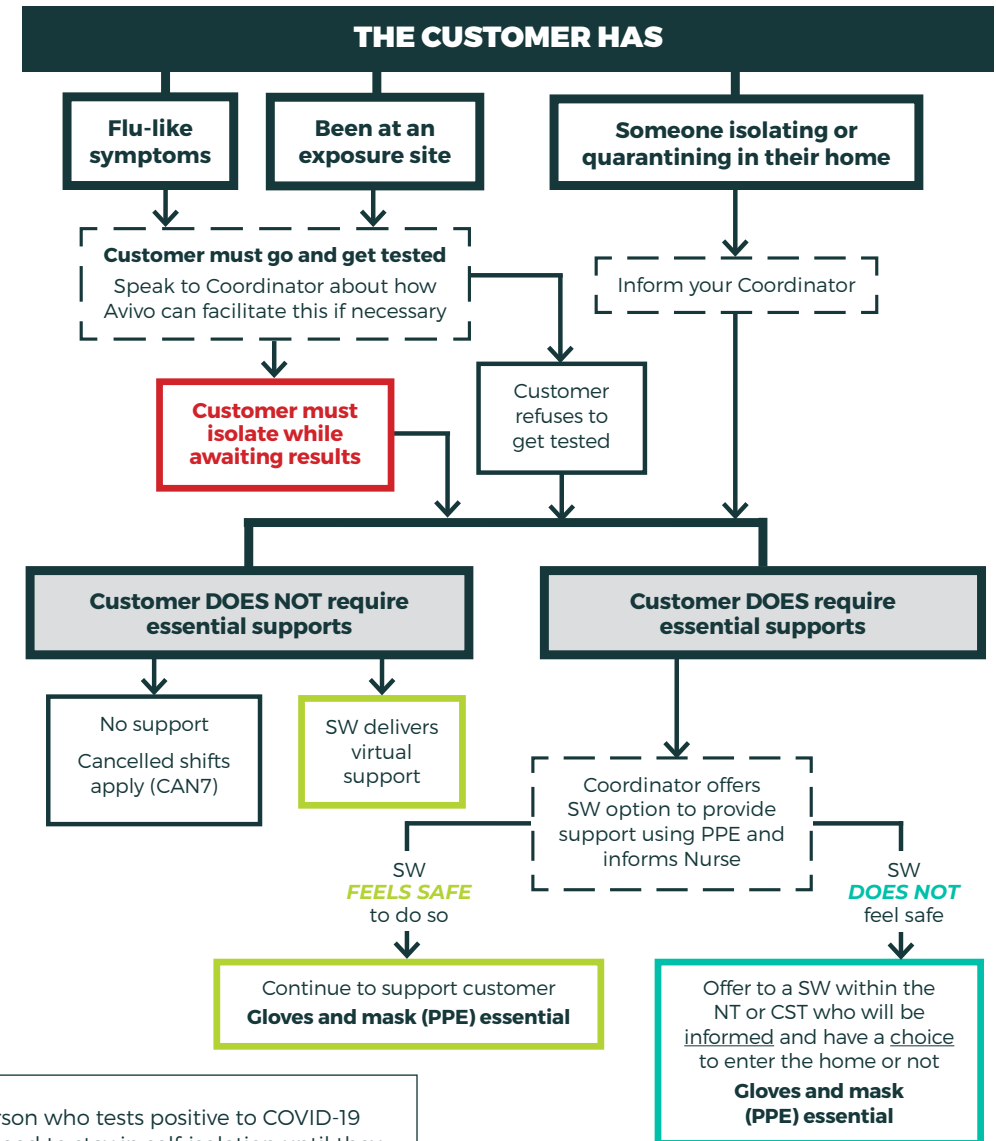
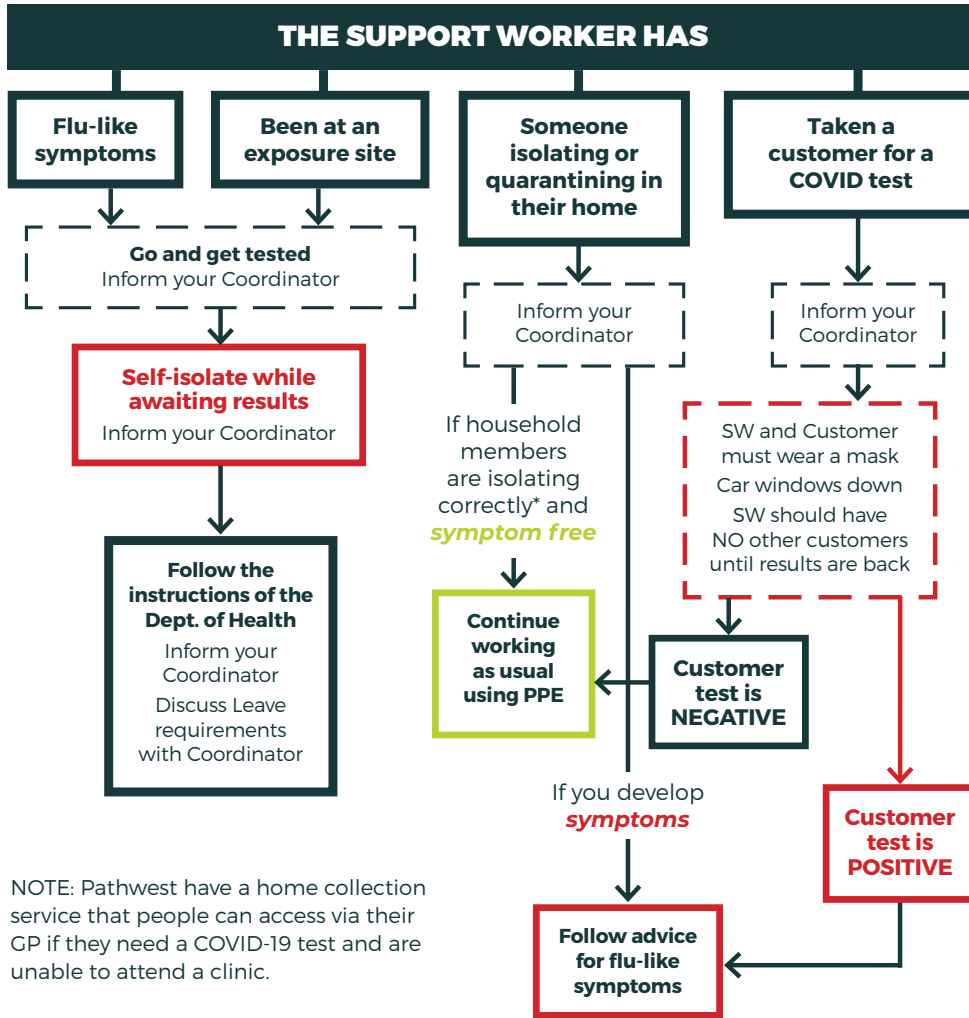


COVID-19: Decision Tree



NOTE: Pathwest have a home collection service that people can access via their GP if they need a COVID-19 test and are unable to attend a clinic.

1 November 2021

Self-isolation means you must remain in your home or accommodation and not have any visitors until you receive test results.

You need to self-isolate if:

- you have undergone a COVID-19 test and are waiting on results
- you have tested positive to COVID-19

Self-quarantine means you must remain in your home or accommodation and not have any visitors for 14 days.

You need to self-quarantine if:

- you have no symptoms but may be at greater risk as you may have had close contact with someone who is unwell with COVID-19
- you've travelled interstate or overseas

A person who tests positive to COVID-19 will need to stay in self-isolation until they are cleared by the Public Health Unit.

*Isolating correctly means the person stays in their own room, has their own bathroom, has no physical contact with others, wears a mask and maintains a 2m social distance in their home or accommodation.
